

COH PROFESSIONALISM, COMPLIANCE, AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

As a student in the College of Health, you are preparing for a career in the health professions, where accountability, professionalism, and respect are essential. To maintain high standards and ensure a productive learning environment, the following policies must be adhered to:

1. Timely Completion of Requirements

All students are required to complete and submit health documentation, immunizations, background checks and other related requirements by the specified deadlines. Failure to meet these deadlines may result in:

- Ineligibility to participate in clinical rotations or coursework.
- Academic or administrative penalties, up to and including dismissal from the program.

It is your responsibility to stay informed of requirements and deadlines. Seek assistance promptly if you encounter challenges meeting these obligations.

2. Professionalism and Respect in All Settings

Students are expected to:

- Demonstrate professional behavior in classroom, clinical experiences, clinical education, field work, internships and community settings by being punctual, prepared, and appropriately attired.
- Exhibit professionalism by communicating respectfully in all settings, including inperson interactions, verbal and non-verbal communication, and written correspondence. This standard applies to interactions with peers, faculty, staff, clinical partners, clients, and caregivers. Respectful communication should be always maintained.
- Follow the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to your health profession.

Disruptive behavior, disrespectful communication, or violations of dress code or ethical guidelines will result in disciplinary action.

Accountability of Actions

As a student in the College of Health, you are accountable for your actions and decisions. Failure to comply with professional expectations may result in consequences, including verbal or written warnings, removal from clinical experiences, clinical education, fieldwork, internships and classroom activities, resulting in potential dismissal from the program.
