

Application for Center Pilot Grant FOR FACULTY AFFILIATES

Instructions:

Provide names, degrees, titles, department and college for all grant participants. At a minimum, the Principal Investigator must be a Center faculty affiliate for this application to be considered, and must be interdisciplinary in nature.

All sections of the application must be completed in 11-point font (Arial in recommended) with .5" margins. Applications may not exceed four pages. Four pages is acceptable. Page limits do not include references.

Please provide a letter of support from each external organization or agency with whom you are partnering. Letters of support and any draft survey instruments should appear at the end as attachments, or an appendix and will not count towards page limit.

Applications not meeting these requirements will be returned to the Principal Investigator, and may be re-submitted, with needed additional information or revisions.

NOTE: Award of funding is contingent upon IRB approval. IRB does not need to be completed prior to submitting this application.

Review Criteria:

- Meets proposal guidelines
- Approaching research from an Interdisciplinary perspective
- Quality of methodology
- Clarity of budget and justification; funds are sufficient to carry out aims of pilot project.
- Proposed Pilot Study is responsive to identified targeted solicitation
- Impact; scope, benefit of research
- Innovation
